Knowing God through Fasting, Praying, Studying and Believing His Word

Our greatest enemy is our mind. It is an open field of landmines filled with doubt, fear, dread, worry, hate, envy, and anxiety, among other trappings, and as children of the Most High, if we are not careful, we will step on these masked dangers, blowing us out of the Kingdom of Heaven. The Scripture declares that the flesh is enmity against God; the flesh is governed by our thoughts, including our imagination. The mind is the control centre of all actions. We have a choice to act or to react, depending on our morality based on the laws of God, which can be entirely subjective, without the directions of and obedience to the Holy Spirit.

One famous philosopher states, "[We] think; therefore, [we] [are]." The emphasis is not our true and real existence. Neither is it existentialism – the physical space that we occupy and the thoughts and actions that govern our existence. As Christians, our hope is secured. Christ is our sale, pun intended; he died to save us, purchasing our sins with his blood, and he is our compass in stormy weather. He called Peter out to walk on water, total control over a raging sea, also demonstrating our ability to rise above the physical world, literally, and our ability to rise above our circumstances, metaphorically. We are also called to walk on water; however, we must learn how to be conquerors, having total control over our minds ultimately our actions. What we see, hear, taste, and feel is all deposited into our minds resulting in actions: negative or positive. Our minds tell us it is impossible because it is not in sync with the physical world or the laws of nature. It is not natural to walk on water, but it is not impossible. Peter saw the vastness of the sea, and he equated it to death, fear, and of course, he began to sink.

How do we use our minds to bend situations? How do we bend our minds to our situations believing that God will do what He says He will do? We must be cognizance of what we consume. Stay away from junk. Paul encourages believers to fill our minds with the virtues of Christ: "Whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things." He goes on further to say, "Be ye transformed by the renewal our minds." Paul's sentiments echo our innate ability to lean towards negatives as oppose to positives, a consequence of Adam's fallen race, the physical and spiritual deaths of humanity.

Usain Bolt, a Jamaican sprinter, and worldwide sensation demonstrates in his feature film, Bolt, what it takes to hold both the 100 metre and the 200 metres world records. For him, training and diet are intense, highly planned and delivered, of course, with arduous work and discipline - 4:00 a.m. drills, Leg Raises, Side Sweeps, Reverse Crunches, Side Plank Clams, Bunny Hops, Box Jumps, Bounding, and Cabe Knee Drive, not to mention a strict diet. People nationwide huddled around their television, glued to their phones and other devices in great anticipation; some with confidence that Bolt will, not only win but he will set world records, at the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio as he had done it before with great strides.



As children of the Most High, we are born winners, again Christ purchased our sins; we are heir of God's Kingdom, but we need to have an attitude of winning, like Bolt, not just in our emotions but our thoughts leading to our actions. Having the mind to run is not enough. If we step on the track overweight and out of shape, we will not even be able to get to the starting line much less on our mark because we will be out of breath just by walking to the starting line. Therefore, are we running this race to win, or are we merely looking for hangout buddies or spectators?

We have the greatest coaches of all time. Our trainer is Christ, our manual is the word of God, and our chief strategist is the Holy Spirit: The mighty three. We need to study the word and write it on our hearts. David says, "I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you." "Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." One person highlights it best, Daniel studied meticulously and recognized what was befalling his people, as written in the Book of Jeremiah, a seventy-year captivity. Fast. Daniel fasted for 21 days, and even though the natural eyes couldn't see the workings of the Most High, answer was on its way. Daniel said that he alone saw the vision and the others with him were filled with terror that they fled. Pray and cease not despite what we see.
