Sometimes in ways that we expect and understand and other times in ways we have no idea how God works it out.

Making plans to have a healthy financial future is always in the God's plan for our life. We should always try to have the knowledge and understanding needed to help make a good decision while seeking God's guidance in our plans and our financial decisions.

In this article, I want to explore a few of the financial plans that always have a lot of questions surrounding them. I am by no means an expert in any of these topics and you should always do your research to make sure these financial practices will work well for your financial needs

A big one is Insurance Policies and its place in our life... needs according to his I believed every person should have a life insurance policy whether it's a Whole Life or Term. augment our retirement plan. Government can also change laws surrounding funding, none of us know what changes will be in place by the time we reach retirement. Different laws could be in place that would totally change what we expected. We can think of retirement income as a basket with money from a corporate plan; our saving and the government. Saving a small amount in an RSP will add up over the years that can be a lot of benefit during the retirement age.

Also having a Registered Education Saving Plan (RESP) for those of us with young children is very beneficial to save towards our children College & University Fee. The monthly payments may at times seem daunting but having that money when your son or daughter is going off to college will be an incredible feeling of blessing you understanding that God was in that plan that help us to find that payment every month. My son just got accepted into college and it was such a relief and a total blessing knowing I have some fund put away to help pay some of the fees. Also, another advantage of having an RESP is being eligible for the Canadian Education Saving Grant, the government can contribute up to \$7,200 to participating RESP.

These are just a few of the financial decisions that I think can be beneficial to us as we plan our financial future. With us not knowing or understanding what our future needs are and what the future hold I believe God is giving us the knowledge and understanding to make plans and decisions that will benefit us in the future.

Matthew 6 tell us about Gods promise to cloth and feed us as he does the birds of the air and he is not slack concerning his promises, having financial plans are good decision but we must obey and observe God's financial wisdom. God's financial wisdom is builds to last not to impress others. An insurance policy is especially important if you have young children. I know the apprehensions that comes with paying for insurance, we all know that the insurance companies are all into this business for themselves and the profit that they can make, but leaving a love one especially a child protected in my opinion out-weights the pain of signing up with these Insurance companies. Having that security in knowing that if anything happens to you or your spouse and you are taking away early, your children will have some money that can help them transition them into a place where they are more independent.

So even having a term insurance when your children are still in school is better that having none. Just to expand a little on the different between a whole life and a term Insurance. Whole Life insurance cost more than term insurance for a comparable amount of coverage, but the premium for whole life will remain the same for the life of the policy. While term insurance cost less but it's only for a term like 10 or 20 years then the premium begins to increase significantly. The benefit of a whole life insurance is that it covers you for life and is a better option, but term insurance can give you much needed immediate security. Term can be used for temporary additional coverage with a permanent life insurance for extra insurance, in some of the most vulnerable times in our life for example when your children are young. Deciding on whole life insurance, term insurance or a mix of both depends on your needs. Insurance can help a family during major illness or disability, it can be a wise way to protect the assets and income God bless us with

Another financial decision is having a Pension Plan, there is the misconception that having our own pension plan will result in not being able to benefit from what we contribute into the Government Pension Plan.

This is not true, having some funds put away to help after retirement is always a good plan, the CPP and OAS were meant to
